Fred Ebb (Author and Lyricist - 1933–2004) was an award-winning lyricist, librettist and director who frequently and successfully collaborated with composer John Kander. Ebb earned four Tony Awards (for Cabaret, Woman of the Year, and Kiss of the Spider Woman) and four Primetime Emmy awards (for Liza with a Z, Gypsy in My Soul, and Liza Minnelli Live From Radio City Music Hall) along with dozens of other accolades, including the Kennedy Center Honors and membership in the American Theatre Hall of Fame. In 2005, by instruction of Ebb's will, the Fred Ebb Foundation was established to present an annual award to an up-and-coming musical theatre writer or writing team.

Charles Ford (*Tech Director/Scenic Designer*) is a master backstage technician and the Technical Director of Merely Players. An avid puppeteer, mask-maker, make-up artist, robotics engineer, and special effects designer, he has designed dozens of sets for a variety of theatrical genres. During his career as Durango High School's tech director and resident designer, Charles was the recipient of several awards, including the Durango Foundation of Educational Excellence's Outstanding Teacher Award and the Rocky Mountain Theatre Association Technical Theatre Award. Charles' world travels have seen him climbing to the top of Machu Picchu, swimming with sea turtles, and riding a camel. He has tried to bring the joy and exhilaration of travel back and use the inspiration to create theatre magic.

Bob Fosse (*Author - 1927–1987*) took an early interest in dance, displaying unusual skill. By his early teens, Fosse was dancing professionally in local nightclubs. He choreographed 1954's *The Pajama Game*, and his signature style, which incorporated complex moves and imagery drawn from vaudeville, was instantly popular. His next musical, *Damn Yankees*, was another smash. Fosse forged a working relationship and marriage with leading dancer Gwen

Verdon that would span his career. Hugely successful by 1960, Fosse still faced opposition from directors and producers who considered his material to be too suggestive. He decided to take on the role of director as well as choreographer in order to maintain the integrity of his artistic vision in Hollywood as well as on Broadway. His subsequent musicals included *Sweet Charity, Cabaret, Pippin, Chicago*, and *All that Jazz*. Fosse remains one of the most distinctive, decorated, and influential choreographers in history.

John Kander (Composer) is a Tony, Emmy and Grammy-winning composer, a recipient of the Kennedy Center Honors Award, and a member of the American Theatre Hall of Fame. With frequent collaborator Fred Ebb, he composed the score to dozens of Broadway musicals, including Cabaret, Zorba, Chicago, The Act, Woman of the Year, The Rink, Kiss of the Spider Woman and Steel Pier. In addition to his Tony, Grammy, and Emmy awards, Kander received honorary doctorate degrees from Oberlin College and Niagara University, the President's Award from the Society of Stage Directors and Choreographers, the Kennedy Center Honors, and the Oscar Hammerstein Award for Lifetime Achievement in Musical Theatre.

Tom Kyser (*Music Director*) retired in 2018 after 44 years in Music Education. During

that time, his DHS choirs performed at Disneyland and Carnegie Hall, as well as at festivalsthroughout Colorado. The highlight of his musical theater career was emerging from the orchestra pit in a sequined jumpsuit and platform shoes (thanks to JoAnn Nevils) to sing "Beauty School Dropout" in the DHS production of *Grease*. Other musical direction credits include Merely Players' *Forever Plaid*, *Dames at Sea, Mamma Mia!*, *Matilda the Musical*, and *Bright Star*. It is with great joy that he's back to work on this production of *Chicago*.

JoAnn Nevils (*Costume Designer*) has been designing and stitching costumes most of her life. Merely Players has been her prime focus for the last 30 years. Every show is memorable, with each costume being created with love and care. One of her goals is to make the actor feel comfortable and special.
