

LIGHTEN UP: Theatre Lighting Workshop

Are you curious about how the complex web of lighting works in the theatre? Would you like to learn the lighting process start to finish? This class will give you the knowledge to come into the Underground and work on a lighting crew.

What we'll cover:

- Understand how a lighting designer works with the director to realize the director's vision.
- Learn the core components of lighting, including the light board, dimmer packs and circuits and how they work together.
- Unravel the mysteries of the light plot. See how different instruments are used for different purposes and how they integrate into the light plot.
- Get some experience of light board basic programming. Discover how a "look" is created and how mixing submasters creates cues in the cue stack.
- Experiment with lighting color gels.
- Go hands-on and design lighting which would enhance a provided acting scene.

The class will start with the basics, assuming participants have little or no knowledge of theatrical lighting. After you've taken this class you'll have the opportunity to help Merely Players with lighting throughout our season.
